ABSTRACT:

We discuss recent empirical and theoretical work that addresses the study of interactions among world countries from a complex-network perspective.

- We ask three main questions:
 - i) What is the topological structure of macroeconomic networks?
 - ii) Are there simple models that can explain that structure?
 - iii) Can the topology of macroeconomic networks explain macroeconomic dynamics?
